

ATTORNEY ADVISOR - Typically, the incumbent: drafts decisions for ALJs in some of the more sensitive and/or legally complex cases involving significant policy issues and questions regarding the application of Federal Circuit Court opinions or Acquiescence Rulings in particular cases; performs research and identifies unusual issues typically related to matters of State law; thoroughly reviews class action cases and cases remanded by the Courts and the Appeals Council; drafts interrogatories to medical and vocational experts; reviews and evaluates highly complex disability cases which require reevaluation to comply with Agency interpretation of U.S. Supreme Court Decisions; responsible for formulating legally defensible decisions which address all medical and legal aspects of even the most difficult cases; and provides information to the claimant and/or his/her representative concerning applicable laws, procedures and requirements.

The pay scale for a SSA Decision Writer as a GS-11 or GS-12 is listed below. Most applicants with prior legal experience will start at the GS-12. If someone starts at a GS-11, they move to a GS-12 after 1 year.

GS-11: \$61,218 and GS-12: \$73,375
